CKAG's own talented member, Theresa Shelton, has agreed to teach an oil painting workshop on Saturday, May 14. She is a featured artist with Ky Artisan Center, Wildchild Art Gallery in Florida, Chestnut Tree Gallery in Richmond, Broken Oak Gallery in Illinois, Liz-Beth & Co, Tennessee, and the Ky Crafted. In April she will exhibit at the Indiana Artisan Market Place in Indianapolis and will be at the Madison Chatauqua Festival of Art in Indiana in September.

A deposit of \$10 will hold your place. Ten artists have express interest in participating. If 15 people agree to participate, the \$10 deposit will be the total cost to each artist. If fewer than 15 people sign up, the \$150 will be divided among those attending. Make checks payable to CKAG and give to Mary Lou at the April meeting or mail to her.



Minutes of March Meeting

The March 2011 meeting was called to order by Rose Cooper with 42 in attendance including 3 visitors.

Treasurer, Sharon Milliner, reported that despite a \$50 withdrawal for the newsletter and a \$10 withdrawal for an advertisement for the Judi Betts workshop, CKAG is still ahead of budget due to an increase in membership.

The Business Exhibits for this quarter are scheduled but participation is needed for the next quarter. Juried members interested in participating can contact Sandra Butler.

The Marianne McDonald pastel workshop is scheduled for April 2. The Judi Betts watercolor workshop is scheduled for August 29-September 2 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Best Western-Atrium Gardens with a 22-person limit. Cost is \$320 for members and \$355 for non-members. The date has been changed to October 22 for the Pam Clegg watercolor workshop. CKAG proposes to book a 1-day oil painting workshop on May 14. There will be a maximum of 15 people with a \$150 fee being divided equally between participants. There is a date of June 25 that is still open for a potential workshop. Additional information is available by contacting Mary Lou Hall.

Phyllis Blakeman reminded everyone of the fundraiser for the Community Health Clinic scheduled for August 19 and invited artists to donate work for the auction.

Dennis Shaffner informed the group that the State Fair wishes to provide areas to showcase working artists in order to create a more interactive experience at the art show. The fair runs from August 18-28. Artists interested in participating can contact Dennis.

The guidebooks for the various chairperson positions within CKAG are in various stages of completion. Any unfinished guidebooks should be completed by next month.

The All Member Show was discussed and a tentative committee was formed to try to fill in the details.

Former member, Carol Reesor, sent notice of interest to purchase some (8) grid art display panels for approximately \$500. CKAG voted 18-8 in favor of selling the walls.

Theresa Shelton is having an Open House on April 30 for her new gallery and shop.

Mary Lou Hall was featured in an article in "The Pioneer News" regarding her work on display in the State Capitol.

The Museum Gallery has transitioned to its display for spring but still needs small items for the glass display cabinets.

Program: Members did sketches from memory of a still life set up by Elsie Hall and Joyce Lupresto. The arrangement was covered several times during the exercise and participants were encouraged to continue to sketch from memory.

MARIANNE MCDONALD PASTEL WORKSHOP

Marianne McDonald of Lexington presented a one-day pastel workshop to sixteen members and visitors at the Nolin RECC building in Elizabethtown. Marianne is a relaxed and knowledgeable instructor. Some newcomers to the media of pastel remarked that pastel painting is a lot of fun (much to their surprise)!

She showed artists her method of preparing the Wallace pastel paper and her steps for getting a correct drawing and underpainting in place before starting to apply the final layers of pastel. Participants followed along with her as she completed her demonstration painting.

Pastels are similar to oils in that you work from establishing darks to lights first. This is the opposite of working in watercolor. She came around to each person at least 3-4 times during the session with suggestions for improving the paintings. She passed around a tip sheet and elaborated more on her reasons for using certain supplies and why she follows certain techniques.

The painting session was followed by a critique of all the class work. She was pleased with the talent of the artists present and complimented all on their work. Everyone commented how much they enjoyed the workshop.

Marianne and some fellow artists are having an art show of their “glorious adventures” of an art trip last year in Italy. The show opens April 4 and closes April 30. The reception is April 8 from 5-8 p.m. at the Kentucky Theater Gallery in Lexington.
